QUESTION	RESPONSE
Will there be a webinar in regards to this RFP?	We will not be offering a webinar in support of the RFP solicitations.
Are we able to set up a video call to see if our idea matches the RFP topics?	We are unable to provide any feedback to applicants in advance of the submission deadline.
Is it possible for one person to be on two separate teams that are submitting unique proposals? Or is an applicant limited to one team and/or proposal?	An individual may be listed on separate proposals.
The RFP indicates that we should assume an April 1, 2022 start date. If we choose a later start date (to better align with the university calendar), such as June 1, 2022, will that be acceptable?	Once a proposal is selected for funding, AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety prefers to execute the contract as soon as possible.
The RFP, “Approaches to Training and Educating Drivers About Advanced Driver Assistance Systems and Vehicle Automation”, refers to both Advanced Driver Assistance Systems (ADAS) and automated driving systems. Are we to focus on automation level 2+ or is there more freedom in the choice of automation level?	The RFP emphasizes technologies that can actively control lateral or longitudinal movement of the vehicle. The applicant is free to decide whether to focus their proposal on a specific level of automation or to consider multiple levels.
Re: “Approaches to Training and Educating Drivers About Advanced Driver Assistance Systems and Vehicle Automation”, will you consider a proposal that focuses on a particular group of drivers (e.g., high-risk young drivers, older drivers)?	We will consider any proposal that sheds insight into the study objectives, including those that target specific populations. However, proposals that are too narrow may review less favorably than others that target a broader population.
Could we find the information on AAA-funded projects (e.g., research topic, project summary, project duration, funding amount) in recent years?	All completed research projects are published as technical reports or research briefs and they are available publicly on AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety’s website. We are unable to release specific information about current or active contracts.
